Dr. Cunningham-Rundles is the David S. Gottesman Professor of Immunology at the Mount Sinai School of Medicine in New York. She is a Professor of Medicine and Pediatrics, a member of the Prism Immunology institute, and directs the Immunodeficiency Clinic at Mount Sinai. She is also a co-Program Director of the Allergy Immunology Fellowship training program. She is a member of the <u>Inborn Errors of Immunity Committee</u> (IEI) of the IUIS. She received her MD from Columbia College of Physicians and Surgeons, and her PhD from New York University School of Medicine. Dr. Cunningham-Rundles is an expert in the more than 450 Primary Immune Deficiency diseases, conditions that result from genetic defects of the immune system.
