He is the author of five books, the most recent of which is Bloody Bioethics: *Why prohibiting donor compensation harms patients and wrongs donors* (Routledge, 2022). He has authored numerous Op-Eds for publications such as the Los Angeles Times, the New York Daily News, and USA Today. His award-winning Op-Ed for the Los Angeles Times was credited with influencing the ruling of the United States 6th District Court circuit that led to the legalization of payment for bone marrow.
